- Create a Family Disaster Plan.
  Have fire extinguishers on hand & train your family how to use them.
  Know where your gas, electric & water main shut-off controls are and how to use them.
  Have several evacuation routes.
  Have an emergency meeting location.
- Appoint an out-of-area friend or relative as a point of contact.Carry a list of emergency contact

Have an emergency supply kit.

- numbers with you and in your emergency supply kit.
- Keep an extra emergency supply kit in your car.
- Have a portable radio or scanner so you can stay updated on the emergency.


## SET!
