The Association achieves this mission by (1) Monitoring proposed new development, (2) Evaluating the City's ongoing plans with the local landfill, (3) Working with Neighborhood Watch, (4) Maintaining a comprehensive disaster preparedness plan, and (5) Fostering community interaction through various social events. The GOCHA Board of Directors is comprised of 15 volunteer members, each elected to a term of 3 years.

## Going to college next year?


If so, you can apply for the GOCHA Scholarship. The homeowners association will award a \$400 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who will attend a post-secondary institution in the academic year following graduation. To be eligible, an applicant must live in Glenoaks Canyon, and at least one member of the household must belong to GOCHA. The application is available on the GOCHA website: www.glenoakscanyon.org or by contacting Marie Freeman at 818-500-1828. Applications must be submitted by May 1, 2020. The GOCHA Scholarship Committee will base their selection on merit and service and will announce the recipient in June, 2020.
