



## RED FLAG WARNING ALERT

### WHAT IS IT?

- Issued by the National Weather Service when weather events may result in extreme fire behavior
- Typically includes low relative humidity, high heat, strong winds, and/or dry fuels

### WHAT ACTION SHOULD BE TAKEN?

- Clear the roadway of vehicles and trash bins allowing for maximum road clearance for emergency vehicles. *+ cars (move into driveway, facing out)*
- Top off your gas tank if below 1/2 tank and back into off road parking space. *+ evacuating cars*
- DO NOT PARK OVER WEEDS (could start a fire).
- Check status of your *Grab and Go Bag*, including important documents, medications and equipment, pet needs, computer back-up, photos/ mementos, valuables.
- Review your *evacuation plan* with your household and be prepared to implement. (A good time for a practice run!)
- Update the info on your I.C.E. (In Case of Emergency) forms.
- Check cash on hand.
- Stay alert for possible evacuations and go ~~when told to!~~ *at first sign of fire!*
- Be alert and report any signs of fire to 9-1-1
